1. On the Job Workbook Overview

This on-the-job workbook is to be completed by learners enrolled in UEECD0047 Supervise and coordinate energy sector work activities (MTS Substation Supervision) who have completed the online learning and online quiz.

The purpose of this workbook is to ensure you undertake actual workplace learning with an appropriate supervisor present to give instructions and guidance on the tasks performed.

This workbook is required to be satisfactorily completed and presented to your assessor before the face-to-face assessment is undertaken. The completed workbook will be retained by the RTO.

2. Instructions to Learner

 the supplementary evidence required for each task.
- The learner must complete at least **four** tasks in this on-the-job workbook under the direct supervision of an appropriately qualified and authorised person.
- The learner should book face-to-face assessment once they have completed four tasks and believe they are competent to perform the job role of Substation Supervisor. Refer to your course information for details on booking assessment.
- The learner may compete additional workbooks if additional on-the-job learning is required to be confident and competent in the tasks.
- The learner should have access to relevant workplace documents, resources, PPE and equipment required to perform the task in your workplace.
